Overtime: Overtime rates for the first two hours worked before, after, or accumulative of the established work day shall be one and one-half (1-1/2) times the regular rate. Saturday work shall be paid for at one and one-half (1-1/2) times the regular rate up to 8 hours. Work over 10 hours shall be double time the regular rate up to 8 hours. Work over 10 hours shall be doubletime. All work on Sundays and holidays shall be paid double time.

Holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, the Fourth of July, Labor Day, Veterans' Day (Nov. 11th), Thanksgiving Day, day after Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. If a holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday is observed.

Reporting Pay: If an employee reports for work and is not placed to work, he shall receive one hours pay. If, however, employee is asked to stay on job site, he shall receive two hours pay. If employee starts work he shall receive four hours pay. If employee starts work after lunch, he shall receive eight hours pay.

4th 6 mths and 1801-2400 hrs - 65%	8th 6 mths and 4201-4800 hrs - 90%
